


**Partnership Agreement
Central Methodist University
St. Louis Christian College**

Central Methodist University (CMU) and St. Louis Christian College (SLCC) agree to join in a partnership for providing access to baccalaureate degree programs in Missouri using a process of inter-institutional articulation through collaboration and cooperation. The partners agree to work together to develop 2 + 2 educational programs, using locally available classrooms for instruction. The partners will share facilities by way of mutually agreed upon facilities use procedures, to maximize educational opportunities to learners.

The partnership educational activities will be governed by joint application of each institution's policies and procedures and by appropriate regulations of respective governing bodies and accreditation agencies. The academic officers of each institution shall serve as liaison officers for the partnership.

The partners will continue to develop the ways and means by which cooperation and collaboration may be facilitated and through which the needs of students can be best served.
