

On a first come, first served basis, 15 entering freshmen admitted to CMU with a minimum comprehensive ACT score of 24 and a 3.5 or higher high school GPA are reserved a seat in the next BSNG cohort after they have completed all programmatic pre-requisite courses.

To be able to claim the reserved seat, the individual student must have:

- a minimum 3.5 collegiate GPA;
- a minimum 3.0 sub-cumulative GPA for BI101, BI107, BI305, CH107 or CH111, and BI305. Labs are required with all science courses except BI305 and CH107; and
- at or above the minimum composite score on the programmatic entrance exam (determined by the department and subject to revision)

Should any individual with a reserved seat drop below the requirements for claiming their reserved cohort seat, they are still potentially eligible for admission to the BSNG under standard admission requirements, but are subject to the same admission review and selection process as applicants with non-reserved seats.

I have met the freshman qualifications of the early admission program and I understand the above expectations must be achieved in order to receive a guaranteed seat in the BSNG cohort.
